The Château Haut Breton Larigaudière 2014 has a pleasant blackberry and briary nose, nicely defined with pretty, cassis scents emerging with time. The palate is medium-bodied with slightly dry tannin, a little austere at present and requiring more flesh on the attenuated finish. It just needs more substance.

The Château Tour Baladoz 2014 has a subtle marine influence on the nose that opens nicely during aeration in the glass. The palate is crisp on the entry with hints of dark chocolate infusing the red and black fruit. This is nicely balanced, not complex, but it has a nascent joie-de-vivre and breeziness on the finish that I hope remains in situ by the time of bottling.
